

Policy Title	Recognition of Achievement Policy
Policy Statement	This policy recognises the achievements of Australian kart racers and is designed to encourage those that compete at the highest level to compete regularly at Ipswich Kart Club's race meetings.
Scope and Application	This policy applies to anyone who is a reigning Karting Australia state or national champion. This policy also applies to the reigning Junior Senior Club Champions.
Effective Date	2017
Compliance	Waiving of nomination fees will be granted upon request
Principles	<p>The club will waive the race nomination fees for any competitor wishing to race at a club championship round for all current Karting Australia State and National Champions. The following conditions must be met.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The competitor is entitled to this benefit throughout the calendar year that they are the reigning Champion.</li> <li>• This benefit is only for the class in which the competitor holds the title.</li> <li>• In the case where a competitor must move up due to age requirements i.e. from juniors to seniors, this benefit will still be honoured provided the competitor is competing in a comparable class.</li> <li>• In the case where a class is generally only run at a national round of competition, this benefit will still be honoured provided the competitor is competing in a comparable class.</li> </ul> <p>The club will waive the practice fees for the current Junior and Senior Club Champions whenever they wish to practice at a club</p>
Review Cycle	The committee will review this policy every 12 months
