

Policy Title	Track/Facilities Usage Policy
Policy Statement	This policy outlines the minimum principles/requirements for the hire of Ipswich Kart Club's track/facilities and is to be applied in conjunction with the Use of Facility and Hire Agreement forms.
Scope and Application	This policy applies to anyone wishing to use the Ipswich Kart Club's track/facilities.
Effective Date	February 2017
Compliance	Non-Compliance with this policy will result in the possibility of being asked to leave the track/facility and/or being banned from the track/facilities.
Principles	 Each driver must sign in and pay for practice at the office before kart is placed on the grid. No admittance to the circuit without wearing a high visibility vest. Covered shoes must be worn on the grid at all times. Kart trolley's must be stowed in the allocated area while kart is on the track. All drivers and pit crew must comply with the rules set out in the Karting Australia Manual. Driving of karts in the pits is prohibited. Refuelling of karts on the grid is strictly prohibited. Smoking, alcohol or drugs in the pits is not allowed. All drivers must wear the proper protective gear at all times. If you are instructed or asked to do something by the practice controller then you must listen and do what is being asked of you. The use of cycles, skateboards, scooters or similar are not permitted in the track/pit area. All persons must hold a valid (Government issued) Driver's license to drive a registered motor vehicle within the perimeter of any KA licensed premises.
Review Cycle	The committee will review this policy every 12 months
