

Policy Title CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS POLICY

Policy Statement	This document outlines the Ipswich Kart Club Championship Points Policy. Stated herein are the eligibility requirements and the points system for the Class Championship and overall Club Championship.
Eligibility	<p>In order to be eligible for a Class Championship members must do the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Compete in at least the minimum number of championship rounds (per class) as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 out of 10 rounds • 5 out of 9 rounds • 4 out of 8 rounds • 4 out of 7 rounds • 4 out of 6 rounds • 3 out of 5 rounds • 3 out of 4 rounds • 3 out of 3 rounds 2. Complete two (2) club duty or working bee for the year, the first one between 1st January and 30th June and the second club duty or working bee completed between 1st July and before the conclusion of the final race meeting for the year. <p><u>Notes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of championship rounds is inclusive of all rounds offered (irrespective of whether a class is or is not dropped the total number of rounds offered determines the minimum to be competed in for championship eligibility). • A Club Duty is described as assistance given to the club on a race day or any other time. Members will be assigned an official duty such as Flag Marshall, Scales Marshall, Grid Marshall or Lap Scoring assistant or any other duty required. Duties are assigned by the Club Race Secretary. • A working bee is described as a full morning helping out at the track from 7.00am to 11.00am with general maintenance and upkeep of the grounds and amenities. • Each working bee or club duty must be signed off by the President, Club Secretary or organising Club Official. • You must register with the club secretary your intention to attend a club duty or working bee and the class the points are to be allocated. • Members may nominate one family member or friend to complete a Working Bee or Club Duty. • Endorsement for flags is NOT counted as a club duty as this is a KA requirement for “P” plate holders.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a competitor is excluded from an entire event zero (0) points will be awarded. • You must be a financial member of IKC at the time of racing to be awarded championship points for that race meeting. • Drop your worst championship round that you attended at the end of the year.

<p>Bonus Points System</p>	<p>Bonus points will be allocated as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 75 bonus points for the first club duty or working bee completed between 1st January and 30th June (1st half of the year) and 75 bonus points for the second club duty or working bee completed between 1st July and before the conclusion of the last race meeting for the year (2nd half of the year). • For each subsequent club duty or working bee completed one free practice pass will be issued or you may allocate 75 points to another competitor. • Per class only - Competitors must complete separate working bees or club duties for each class they race in to obtain bonus points for that class. • Once allocated, bonus points cannot be transferred to a different class or competitor. • Drop Your Worst - Your worst result for a race meeting will automatically be dropped from the final points table after the final round of the year. You cannot drop a round that you did not attend or a DSQ from an entire round/race meeting. 																																								
<p>Class Championship Count back System</p>	<p>In cases where there is a tie for a place, the following rules will apply:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The winner is the competitor who completed the most class championship rounds. 2. If still tied then the winner is the competitor who has the most top finishes (i.e. more 1st places etc). 3. If still tied then each tied competitor will be awarded as equal champions.
