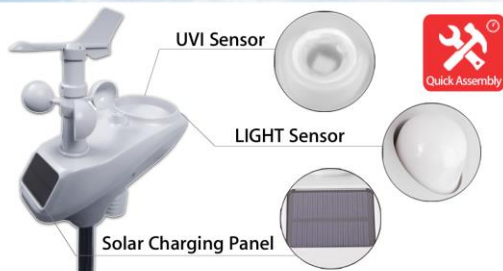


Weather Station: despite much research, I haven't found anything 100% suitable that has a camera and that isn't an absolute bomb at the end of the day. The camera isn't a huge necessity. What I have found is the Pantech WS2900 is most suitable, this has live data feed, so you'll be able to see whether it has rained in the last minutes etc.



Recommend 3x AA Batteries

**Tips:** For better result, countries in the southern hemisphere (such as Australia and New Zealand) should set the solar panel facing north.  
 100 % Support Southern Hemisphere. (Southern Hemisphere Wind Direction ReCalibration instruction included in the Manual Already.)
