IKCP03 - ODS / ITP Policy	
Policy Statement	<p>This policy outlines the minimum principles/requirements for the ODS (Observed Driving Session) required by Karting Australia and the ITP (Induction and Training Process) required by Ipswich Kart Club for IKC members.</p> <p>The term “Club” refers to Ipswich Kart Club and the Management Committee.</p> <p>The term “Member” refers to the Member or Participant License Holder who agrees to the below requirements.</p>
Scope and Application	<p>This policy applies to any driver who has completed a suitable amount of Social Karting Activity (General Practice) and desires to take the step to compete and enter an IKC race meeting.</p>
Effective Date	1/01/2024
Compliance	<p>The ODS (Observed Driving Session) and ITP (Induction and Training Process) are both required to be completed and marked off in KOMP, before a race entry will be accepted by Ipswich Kart Club.</p>
Principles of Agreement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Karting Australia requires all Licence Holders to successfully complete an ODS (Observed Driving Session) before they can enter their first race meeting. The ODS is observed by an Official appointed by IKC (Ipswich Kart Club) and upon successful completion, that Official will mark the ODS Certification off in KOMP. To book a day/time for an ODS, email Ipswich Kart Club at ikcadmin@ipswichkartclub.org.au Cadet drivers are required by Karting Australia to complete 8 x Social Karting Activity sessions and have these 8 x sessions logged in KOMP, before they can request to complete the ODS (Observed Driving Session) Ipswich Kart Club requires all Licence Holders who have requested and completed an ODS (Observed Driving Session) conducted by Ipswich Kart Club, to also undertake the ITP (Induction and Training Process) of Ipswich Kart Club. The ITP has two (2) parts, the Induction part and the Training part. The Induction part of the ITP (Induction and Training Process) will be presented by an Official appointed by Ipswich Kart Club, immediately after the completion of the ODS (Observed Driving Session) and will be considered part of the successful completion of the ODS (Observed Driving Session)

- The Training part of the ITP (Induction and Training Process) will be presented by appointed Officials at an Ipswich Kart Club race meeting. For Senior drivers (16 years plus) this will require the driver to volunteer for an Ipswich Kart Club race meeting and undertake volunteer duties as directed by Ipswich Kart Club. For Junior and Cadet drivers, the Training part of the ITP (Induction and Training Process) will be undertaken by their Participant Licence Holder linked to their Karting Australia Licence and will require that Participant Licence Holder to undertake volunteer duties as directed by Ipswich Kart Club at an Ipswich Kart Club race meeting.
- **No new Ipswich Kart Club Member will be able to enter a race meeting at Ipswich Kart Club without the full completion of all the ODS (Observed Driving Session) and ITP (Induction and Training Process) requirements.**
